WHY CAMP WELL?

Jenn Jett kept hearing the same thing from women leaders:

"I am sitting in the tension of feeling too much and not enough." This lie is constantly threatening to change the way women see themselves, leaving them weary and wandering. This identity crisis is keeping leaders from walking confidently in their God-given assignment, leading to burn out as they strive to *do* and to *be* out of their own strength.

Camp Well is six month experience and in person gathering created for 40 women to:

- ▶ REFLECT on who God says they are
- ▶ REFOCUS their next right steps to align with their gifts
- ▶ RESET their lives to operate out of God's strength

▶ Learn the importance & value of a community of dream defenders that will become a support system.

▶ Coaching & group mentoring with seasoned ministry leaders and counselors.
